





















My **grandma** was taken to the hospital and there is nothing wrong with her! She probably only needs a new wheelchair!

You're right, sounds like she needs a new chair, but did she really need to be admitted to the hospital? Hmm.



The Accommodator has great knowledge in accessibility and tech. He would be glad to check out the ramp for any damage.


The last thing Grandma wants is to leave her home! She loves her neighbors and being a part of the community. The ramp is her bridge to






















